

**AVERAGE FEEDBACK ANALYSIS ON CURRICULUM AND ITS TRANSACTION  
BY THE STUDENT, TEACHER, ALUMNI AND EMPLOYER OF PRAVABATI  
COLLEGE, MAYANG IMPHAL FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2020-21**



**Feedback from Students**

1. A total of 75% of the students rated very good regarding the feedback on the content of syllabus of courses and 25% of the students rated good.
2. 60% of the students rated good while 40% rated very good on the availability of books and journals in the library.
3. 68% and 32% of the students rated fair and good respectively on the relevance of courses to the latest and/or future technologies.
4. 75% of the students rated good and 25% rated very good regarding the feedback on the class rooms for effecting delivery of the teachers.
5. 70% and 30% of the students rated good and very good respectively on the feedback related to the quality of teaching in the college.
6. 80% and 20% of the students rated fair and good on the feedback regarding the teacher's approach about their overall development.
7. 70% of the students opined fair as feedback on the transparency of the evaluation system in the college while 30% of the students rated good.
8. 85% and 15% of the students rated good and fair respectively on teacher follow up regarding the assigned task with the students.
9. 80% and 20% of the students rated very good and good respectively on the feedback relating the syllabus covered in the class.
10. 60% of the students rated fair and 40% rated good on the use of teaching aids and ICT in the class by the teachers.

**Feedback from Alumni**

1. 70% of the alumni opined good feedback on the rating of the coverage of courses during programme while 30% of the alumni said fair in the feedback.
2. 80% and 20% of the alumni opined good and fair feedbacks respectively on the rating of the quality of course content during the entire programme.
3. 30% and 70% of the alumni opined good and fair feedbacks respectively on the rating of the curriculum that helps in their employment.

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4. 65% of the alumni opined good feedback on the rating of the syllabus applicability to real life situation while 35% of the alumni said fair in the feedback.

4. 80% and 20% of the teachers opined very good and good feedbacks respectively on the illustration of examples and applications while teaching.
5. 20% and 80% of the teachers opined very good and good feedbacks respectively on the rating of college for effective delivery of the academic process.
6. 20% of the teachers opined very good feedback on the terms of their relevance to the latest or the future technologies while 30% and 50% opined good and fair feedbacks respectively.
